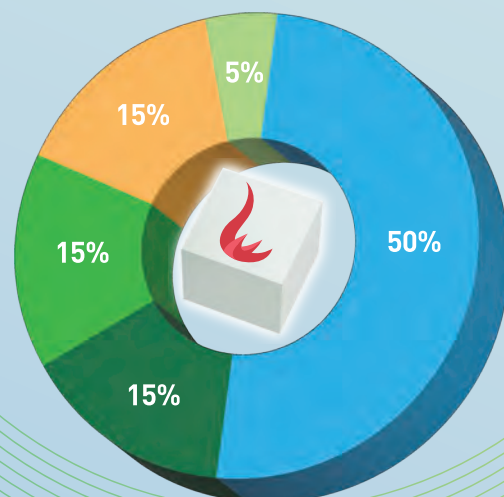

PROGRAM-BASED ADMISSION

Joint University Programmes Admissions System (JUPAS) Application

Prospective local secondary school students may apply for EVMT through JUPAS. Successful candidates will be admitted directly to EVMT directly.

Non-JUPAS Application

Interested students holding international qualifications, local sub-degree qualifications or post-secondary or other qualifications may submit applications through the HKUST Online Application System. Successful candidates will be admitted directly to EVMT directly.
